## Maya Black



Area VII Adult Rider Program is pleased to welcome back our own Area VII superstar Maya Black. Her top results included a win at the Unionville CCI4\*-S in 2014, a win at The Fork CCI4\*-S in 2016, and an amazing third in their CCI5\*-L debut at the Rolex Kentucky Three-Day Event, earning them the traveling reserve spot for that year's Olympic team.

Maya is continuing her top placings in the FEI upper levels and was named to the Adequan® USEF Futures Team Challenge for 2020.

Carol is a nationally known event rider, instructor and coach. She was long listed for the Olympics, short-listed twice for the Pan American Games, named several times to the national Developing Rider Program and was a national Preliminary Champion.

Her remarkable partnership with the Connemara stallion "Hideaway's Erin Go Bragh" brought her into the limelight. After her victory at the Ledyard 3-Day in 1992 and AHSA Zone 2 Advanced Championship in 1995. Carol successfully spearheaded a five year effort to have an FEI rule regarding minimum weight required in 3-Day events to be changed. The rule was successfully changed in 1997. This ultimately led to Carol becoming the president of the USEA.
